Well, we do seem to be heading back to a normal way of life, with doggy classes and dog shows starting up again. Unfortunately the CTRF Fun Day was cancelled this year, but we are all booked to go ahead with the 2022 Fun Day on Saturday 24th September in Leicester. Our calendars and new Christmas cards are already on sale, you can buy the calendars from eBay or from Marilyn Hawkins and the Christmas cards from Chris Roberts.
